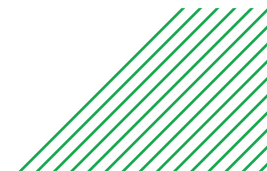
Solid blue, black, or khaki bottoms are allowed. Alternatively, pants can be purchased through the French Toast app. Closed-toe shoes are required.

Pants and other items can be purchased through the French Toast app.



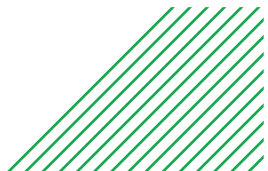
Any athletic closed toe shoe or boots are required. **NO** high heels, flip flops, sandals, or crocs.
